### *Holistic Student Development*

April 30-May 1, 2025

The mission of the Transformational Teaching & Learning Conference (TTLC) is to celebrate and promote a culture of teaching excellence and innovation at Texas A&M University. All who create learning experiences for Texas A&M students (undergraduate, graduate, and/or professional) are encouraged to propose a presentation. TTLC 2025 will showcase the theme *Holistic Student Development*, in which we explore approaches that encourage student intellectual, emotional, social, and ethical growth through integrative approaches that foster student well-being and success both within and beyond coursework. This year will include two days with invited plenary sessions, interactive participant-driven facilitated sessions, a theme-inspired plenary workshop, and concurrent in-person presentations by you and your colleagues. Additionally, we will showcase recent recipients of the highest honors for teaching excellence at Texas A&M University with TED-style talks.

### Apply to Present

To propose a presentation for 2025 TTLC enter the following information via [THIS FORM](#)

- In 3000 characters (~500 words) or less write a proposal for a 10-minute presentation. In your narrative describe:
  - Presentation objectives
  - Target audience (preferably spanning multiple disciplines and/or contexts)
  - Connection with the conference theme of *Holistic Student Development*
  - Best practices/innovative techniques featured
- Indicate those tracks within the conference for which you see the best fit for your presentation:
  - Fostering student life-readiness and well-being
  - Conducting scholarship of teaching and learning (SoTL)
  - Course and Curriculum Design
  - Digital learning and Technology-enhanced engagement
  - Immersive student-centered learning approaches (e.g. *activity-based, community-based, design-based, game-based, inquiry-based, project-based, service-based, team-based, travel-based* etc.)
  - Innovative use of traditional approaches
  - Mentoring approaches
  - Small changes that deliver big results
  - Teaching and learning with AI
- Compose a 500-character (~80 words) or less description of the presentation for the conference program.

### Application Review

- Proposals will be reviewed by the TTLC steering committee according to the rubric provided
- Proposals are due Wednesday, February 5, 2025
- Notifications of acceptance will be sent by Friday, March 7, 2025
